NLC- Endorsement of Members Seeking Office

The Board of Directors are authorized to vote on and submit an endorsement for any MML member(s) who meet the following criteria:

1. Municipal candidates must have held an elected office for at least two years and have at least one year remaining in their term following a NLC Board appointment.
2. Candidates must represent an NLC direct member city.
3. Candidates must receive the official endorsement of both the municipality and chapter.
4. Candidates must have served on an MML standing committee or have been elected to the MML Board of Directors for no less than two years or two terms to receive MML Board endorsement.
5. Candidates must have served on an NLC Steering, Policy Committee or special committee to gain MML Board endorsement for the NLC Board of Directors, as recommended by National League of Cities.

Those seeking endorsement must submit a formal letter of request for endorsement to the MML Board of Directors, which must include both the municipality and chapter endorsement letters supporting the endorsement no later than September 1st. Any request should be addressed to the current MML President and submitted to the CEO.
